

For current Year 10 students going into Year 11 in 2024

Subject selection for 2024 has two phases:

- Phase 1: students submit their subject preferences for 2024 via the online portal. These are the subjects that you would *like* to do in 2024 → **must be done by Monday 21 August.**
 - These preferences will determine the subjects that are offered for 2024, and which lines the subjects are offered on.

Phase 2: students submit their subject nominations for 2024 via the online portal. These are the subjects that you *are choosing to do based on the lines offered* (providing enough students select the subject to make it viable) → **you must have these entered before your subject confirmation interview on either Tuesday 12 or Wednesday 13 September.**

Subjects being offered for 2024 at Stage 1:

- Subjects in **blue** are compulsory subjects and must be chosen.
- Subjects in **black** are one semester elective subjects, and can be chosen only once, but may be chosen in either semester.
- Subjects in **orange** can be chosen as electives in one or both semesters
- Subjects in **green** are elective full year subjects that, if chosen, must be chosen in both semesters.

* Students must select one of either English or Essential English to study for the entire year.

** Students must select one of either Essential, General or Mathematical Methods to study in Semester 1. They may then choose to study either General Maths or Mathematical Methods as an elective in Semester 2.
