

## For current Year 11 students going into Year 12 in 2024

Subject selection for 2024 has two phases:

- Phase 1: students submit their subject preferences for 2024 via the online portal. These are the subjects that you would *like* to do in 2024 → **must be done by Monday 21 August.**
  - These preferences will determine the subjects that are offered for 2024, and which lines the subjects are offered on.

Phase 2: students submit their subject nominations for 2024 via the online portal. These are the subjects that you *are choosing to do based on the lines offered* (providing enough students select the subject to make it viable) → **you must have these entered before your subject confirmation interview on either Tuesday 12 or Wednesday 13 September.**

Year 12 students are expected to study 4 subjects in order to be eligible for an ATAR.

However, if you have completed a Year 12 subject or a Certificate III VET course (not Cert III in retail) in 2022 or 2023, you may choose to study only 3 subjects. This will be confirmed at your subject confirmation interview.

- General Mathematics and Mathematical Methods

\* If you wish to choose Specialist Mathematics, you must also choose Mathematical Methods.

\*\* You can choose as many Design Technology subjects as you wish to count towards your SACE, but only 2 subjects (40 Credits) can be used towards your ATAR.
